



# How to Join Tennessee Harm Reduction Project ECHO

## STEP 1: Go to [Tennessee Harm Reduction ECHO](#)

Or scan the QR Code to access the TN Harm Reduction ECHO platform

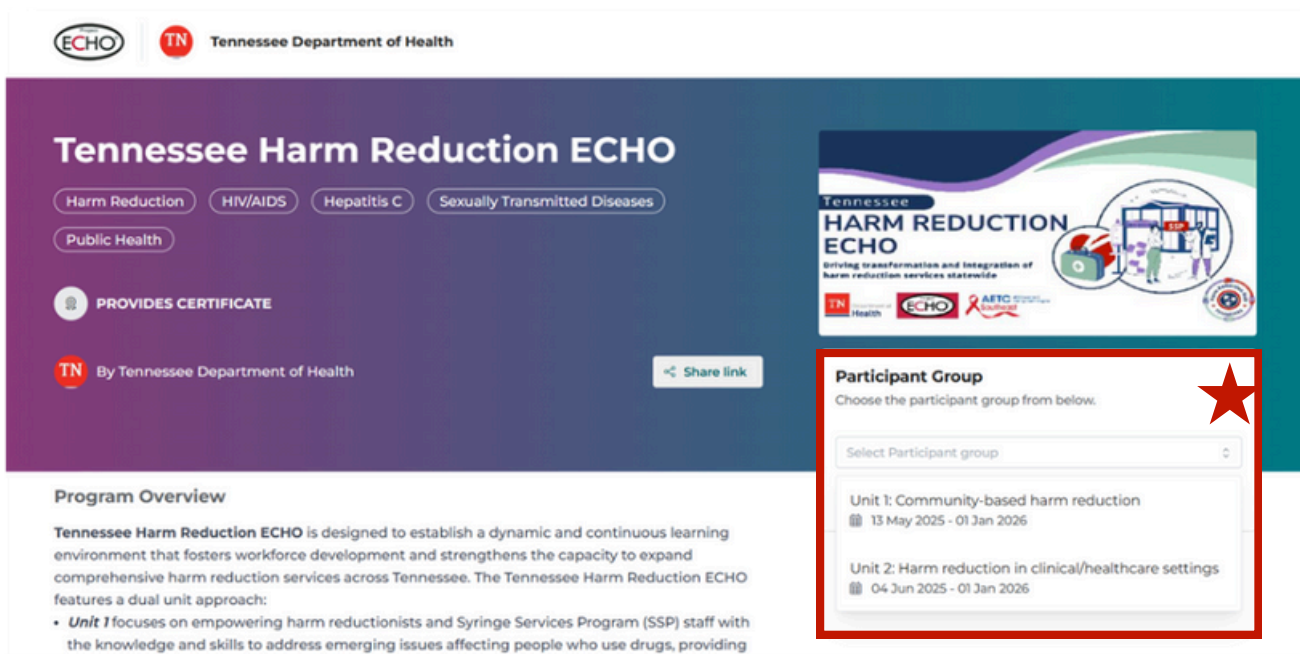

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## STEP 2: Choose a Participant Group

- Next you will need to select a “Participant Group”
  - Located at right-hand side of page
  - ★(see image below for reference).
  - *Note: you can only choose one group at this time, but later you can enroll in both groups. To access the first session, please choose Unit 1.*
- Once you select a participant group click “Register Now”



### Unit Descriptions:

- *Unit 1 is designed to equip in-the-field staff with the knowledge and skills to address emerging issues impacting people who use drugs in non-clinical settings. The intended audience includes, but not limited to, harm reduction specialists, certified peer recovery specialists, and SSP staff.*
- *Unit 2 is designed to equip medical providers and health professionals with the tools to integrate compassionate, evidence-based care for people who use drugs into clinical practice. The intended audience includes healthcare workers such as local health department staff, hospital and ER teams, EMS/first responders, and others serving this population in clinical settings.*

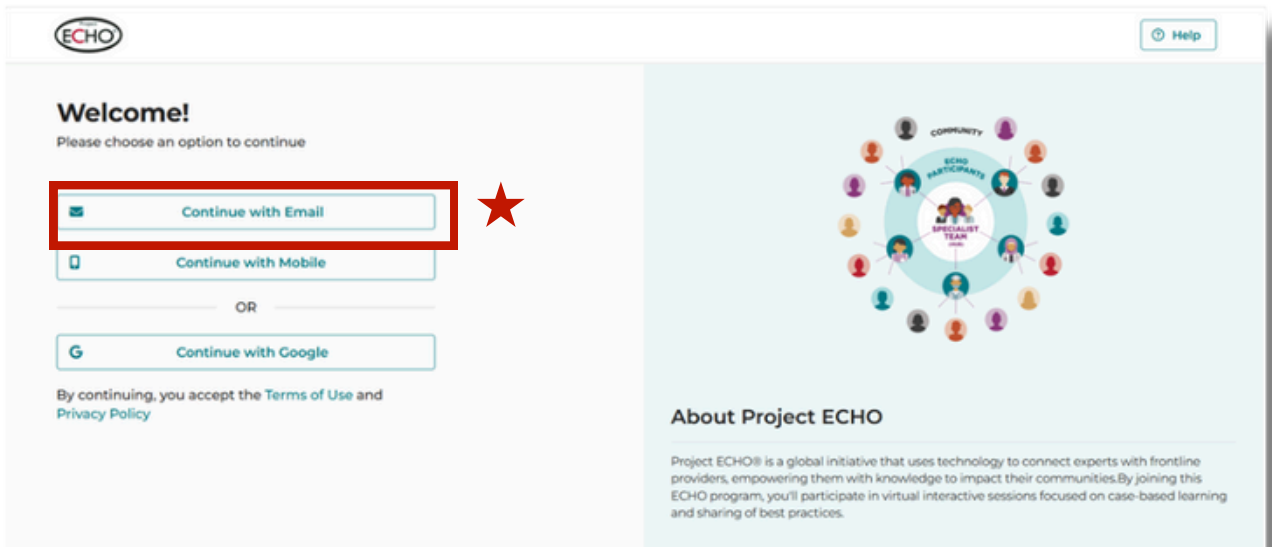
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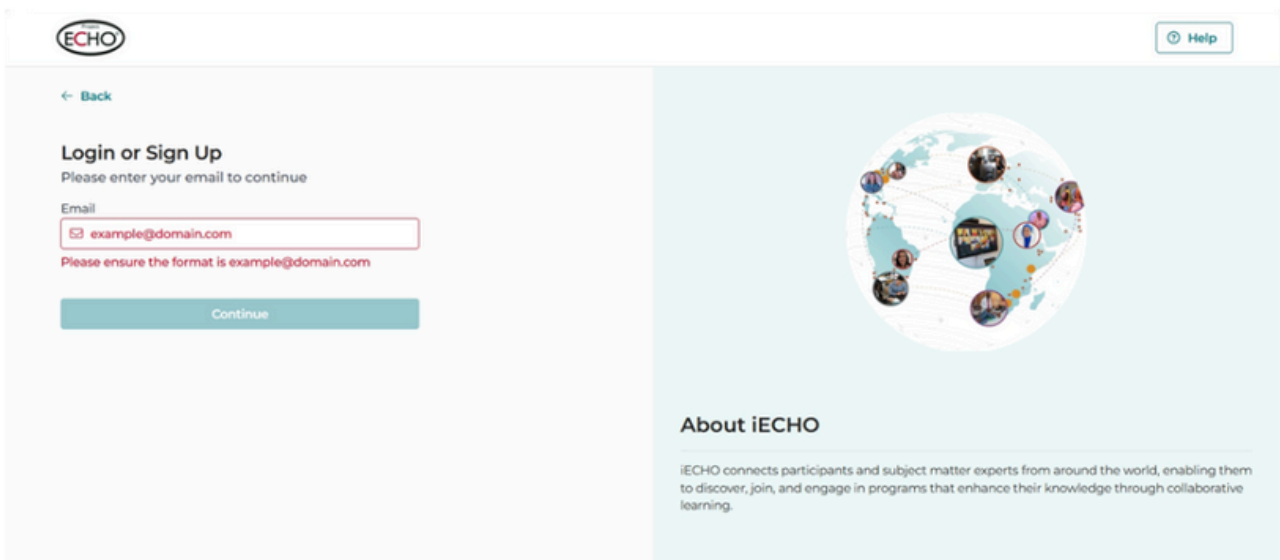
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## STEP 3: Create an ECHO platform account.

- Next you will be routed to the ECHO platform registration page.
  - Click "Continue with Email"



- On the next page, enter the email you would like to use and click continue.



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## Step 4: Continue account creation- Personal Details

- Next page, fill in personal details and create a password
  - **Note:** Password must have a minimum of 10 characters.
- Once filled in, click the checkbox “read and agree to term of use and private policy”
- Then click “Agree and Continue”

- Next you will be instructed to enter a 6-digit verification code.
- You will need to access your email inbox for the 6-digit code.
- Enter on the verification page
  - *image on the right for reference*
- Click “Agree & Continue”

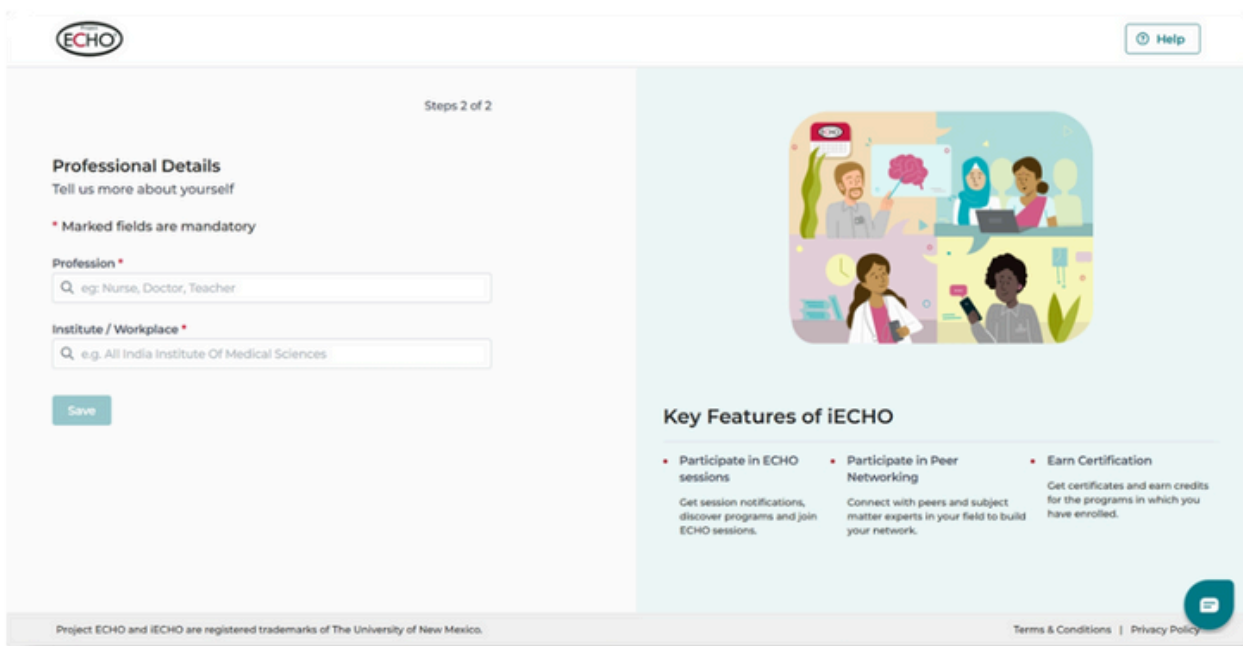
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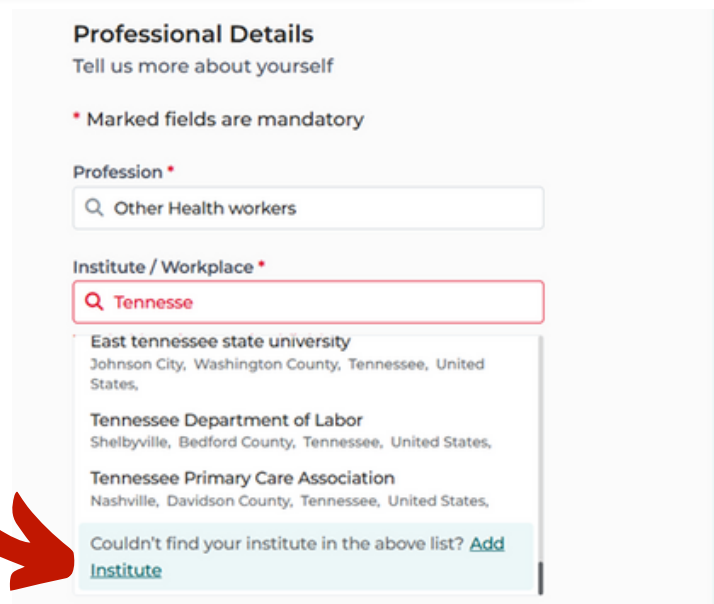
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## Step 4: Continue- Professional Details

- Next page, fill in professional details
- *Profession Section*: select the closest profession option, if you cannot find your profession you can use “Other”



- *Workplace Section*: Type in institute or workplace.
- If your workplace is not currently listed, scroll down to and click “Add an Institute”



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## Step 4b: Add a workplace (if needed)

- On the same page, a popup screen will appear.
- Add your workplace name
- Add your workplace location which will be city and state
  - *Example:* Nashville, Tennessee
- Click Submit
